

# Scholarship Program

The Kansas Livestock Foundation (KLF), in conjunction with Merck Animal Health, GoBob Pipe & Steel, Hampel Oil, Central Life Sciences/Altosid IGR and the Kansas CattleWomen, is offering several scholarships for the 2021-22 school year. By submitting an application, you apply for all the scholarship categories for which you qualify. Each candidate is eligible to win only one scholarship. Applicants must be graduates of a Kansas high school and enrolled at a Kansas community or senior college for the Fall 2021 semester. Previous winners of any KLF scholarships are ineligible, with the exception of graduate and veterinary students who have not previously received the Merck Cartridges for Cash Vet Student scholarship or the Altosid IGR \$1,000 scholarship.

#### Award Process

- Applications will be reviewed by the Kansas Livestock Foundation Scholarship Selection Committee.
- Awards will be paid directly to the recipient upon receipt of proof of enrollment.

#### **Application Requirements**

- Cover letter describing your background, livestock enterprise, career and education plans, your most important achievement and why you deserve/need a scholarship.
- Completed application You must use the form provided, or recreate a form using the same format. <u>All information must be typed.</u>
- Resume
- Contact information for 2-3 references
- Transcript(s)
  - o If sophomore level or below, college and high school transcripts are required
  - Include junior college transcripts if applicable
  - o Veterinary students also must submit undergraduate transcript
  - o Transcripts need not be official

### Awards & Eligibility

- Merck Animal Health Cartridges for Cash \$1,500 Vet Student Scholarship -Any Kansas State University veterinary medicine student with a career goal of being a large animal veterinarian.
- Merck Animal Health Cartridges for Cash \$1,000 Scholarship Any student attending a Kansas community or senior college in the fall of 2021 and pursuing a degree in agriculture or a related field. Preference will be given to Kansas State University and Fort Hays State University students entering their junior or senior year and majoring in Animal Sciences with a career goal of being actively engaged in livestock production.

The county that turns in the most cartridges by February 28, 2021, will receive a Cartridges for Cash scholarship for at least one student from that county (providing there is a qualified applicant).

- GoBob Pipe & Steel Cattlemen's \$1,000 Scholarship Any student entering their sophomore year or above in the fall of 2021 at a Kansas community or senior college and pursuing a degree in agriculture or a related field.
- Hampel Oil/Mobil Delvac \$1,000 Scholarship Any student entering their junior or senior year in the fall of 2021 at Kansas State University or Fort Hays State University and pursuing a degree in agronomy, agribusiness, or ag economics. Preference will be given to applicants with a career goal of being actively engaged in a farming or feedyard enterprise.
- Altosid IGR \$1,000 Scholarship Any student entering their junior or senior year, graduate or vet school in the fall of 2021 at Kansas State University or Fort Hays State University and pursuing a degree in agriculture. Preference will be given to students majoring in animal sciences and industry with a career goal of being actively engaged in livestock production or veterinary services.
- Kansas CattleWomen \$1,000 Scholarship Any student attending a Kansas community or senior ۲ college in the fall of 2021, and pursuing a degree in dietetics, food safety, agriculture, or a related field.
- Douglas A. Laue Memorial Kansas Livestock Foundation \$1,500 Scholarship Any student entering their junior or senior year in the fall of 2021 at Kansas State University or Fort Hays State University and pursuing a degree in agriculture.
- Glenn & Clyde Lindstrom Kansas Livestock Foundation \$1,000 Scholarship Any student entering their sophomore year or above in the fall of 2021 at a Kansas community or senior college and pursuing a degree in agriculture. Preference will be given to students residing within the boundaries of Unified School District 400 in northern McPherson and southern Saline counties.
- Kansas Livestock Foundation Youth in Agriculture \$1,000 Scholarship Any student attending a Kansas community or senior college in the fall of 2021 and pursuing a degree in agriculture or related field.
- Scott Johnson & Family Kansas Livestock Foundation \$1,000 Scholarship Any student ٠ attending Kansas State University in the fall of 2021 and pursuing a degree in animal sciences and industry. agricultural communications and journalism, agribusiness or agricultural economics.
- Farmers Feed Kansas Livestock Foundation \$500 Scholarship Any student attending a Kansas community or senior college in the fall of 2021 and pursuing a degree in agriculture or a related field. Preference will be given to students majoring in animal sciences and industry or agricultural communications and journalism.

The number of scholarships awarded in each category will be dependent upon funds available and the number of qualified applicants.
